In order to fill in and sign the Emergency Request for sick leave form you will need to perform the following steps.

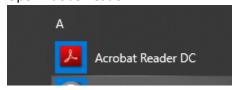

You only need to download the reader. Make sure you uncheck the boxes for the addon's like MacAfee.

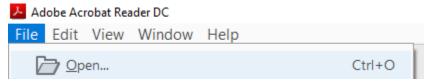
2. Once installed you can download the form from the Employee Information screen located at http://www.haartz.com/company/employee-information

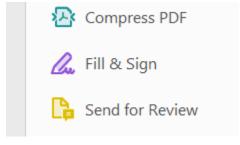
- 3. Save the document to your local computer.
- 4. Open Adobe Reader



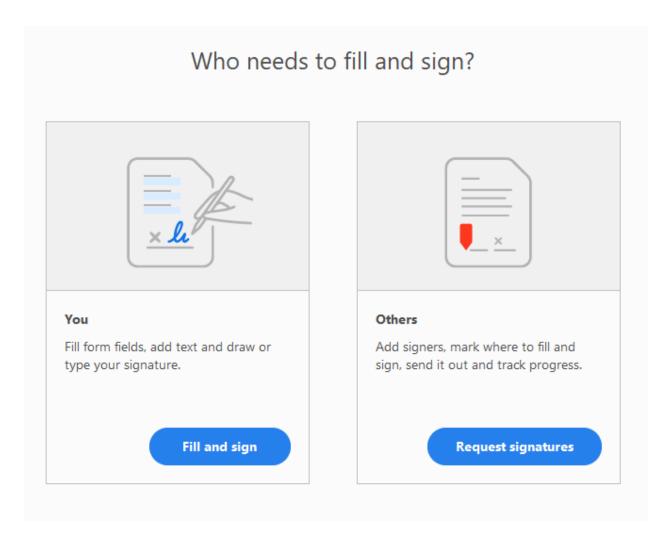
5. Click File then Click Open

- 7. Look on the right side of the screen and find the Fill and Sign Option.



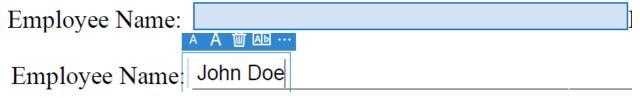
8. When you click on the option you will be presented with the screen below. Please click the Fill and Sign Option.

10. The Ab is for filling in the form. Just click on the field you would like to fill in and enter the required information.



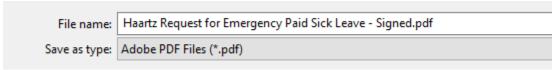
11. To Sign the form, click the Sign Function on the Menu Bar.
