On January 10, the Biden administration finalized guidance for commercial insurance coverage of over-the-counter (OTC) COVID-19 tests for diagnostic purposes without a prescription at a \$0 member cost share, effective January 15, 2022.


## How to get your CVS OTC COVID-19 tests without a prescription with your CVS CareMark prescription coverage:

- Submit for a direct member reimbursement: get reimbursement for OTC COVID-19 tests without a prescription
  after purchase until the end of the Public Health Emergency (PHE). Members can upload a copy of their receipt
  of the OTC COVID-19 tests purchased via <a href="https://www.caremark.com/">https://www.caremark.com/</a> to submit for reimbursement or submit a
  paper claim.
  - Members will be reimbursed, and the plan will pay the lesser of the full retail price paid by the member, or the \$12 per test reimbursement limit established by the Administration in the direct coverage safe harbor.
- Access direct coverage: your plan will cover the cost of OTC COVID-19 tests with direct reimbursement to the pharmacy and no upfront out of pocket cost for members.
